You can see this space by going to gobasics.atlassian.net/wiki and clicking on Spaces in the sidebar. The other statements are not necessarily true, as they depend on other factors, such as how many products, admins, or projects you have added to your site. QUESTION 2

Which statement is FALSE about creating new sites and organizations?

- A. You can add a new product to an existing site.
- B. You can create a new site without an organization.
- C. You can add a new product to a new site and organization.
- D. You can create an empty organization without any products.

Correct Answer: B

This statement is false because every site belongs to an organization. When you create a new site, you either join an existing organization or create a new one. QUESTION 3

Holly just signed up for a new Confluence Cloud site.

What was definitely created along with the site?



- A. two products

Correct Answer: D

When Holly signed up for a new Confluence Cloud site, two groups were definitely created along with the site. These are the default groups for Confluence: confluence-users and site-admins. The confluence-users group grants access to Confluence and allows users to create and edit pages. The site-admins group grants administrative privileges for Confluence and allows users to manage global settings, templates, permissions, and more¹² References = Manage product access, Manage groups

QUESTION 4

You set Jira as the landing product on your site.

Bob is a new user and you granted him product access to Confluence only.

What will happen when Bob logs into the site for the first time?

- A. Bob will see a landing page in a Confluence space.
- B. Bob will be sent a new invitation link for Jira.
- C. Bob will be prompted to request access to Jira.
- D. Bob will see the default dashboard in Jira.
- E. Bob will be added to the default access group for Jira automatically.

Correct Answer: C

When Bob logs into the site for the first time, he will be redirected to the landing product, which is Jira. However, since he does not have product access to Jira, he will see a message that says "You don't have access to this product" and a button that says "Request access". If he clicks on the button, an access request will be generated for Jira, which will need to be approved by a product admin. References Set your site's landing product Request access to a product

QUESTION 5

Your organization has multiple sites and Ann is a user.

The domain of Ann's email address is not verified.

What is possibly true about Ann's account?

- A. She has a managed account in another organization.



- B. You can enforce two-step verification on her account.

Correct Answer: A

If Ann's email domain is not verified by your organization, it means that you do not own or manage her account. However, she may have a managed account in another organization that has verified her domain. In that case, you cannot enforce security policies, deactivate, or delete her account.
