Correct Answer: B

A Sprint Report is the best report to provide a single comprehensive list of issues that were completed in the last sprint. A Sprint Report shows the scope, status, and completion date of each sprint. It also displays a breakdown of the completed, incomplete, and added issues in the sprint. The team can see the story points associated with each completed issue, as well as the issue type of each completed issue. They can also see the description of each issue that has not been completed by clicking on the issue key or summary. A Sprint Report also helps to track the team's performance and identify any scope changes during the sprint. QUESTION 2

The team wants to flag issues using a category. Their requirements are:

Which field meets their requirements?

Correct Answer: D

The label field meets the team's requirements for flagging issues using a category. Labels are a type of custom field that allow users to add one or more descriptive tags to issues. Users can add new labels on the fly, and select existing labels from a dropdown menu. Labels can be re-used across all projects, and can be searched and filtered easily. A text field does not allow multiple values or a dropdown menu. A component does not allow multiple values or adding new values by any user. A user picker does not allow multiple values or adding new values by any user. Checkboxes do not allow adding new values by any user. QUESTION 3

Your team failed to meet their last sprint commitment and you want to investigate further. You need an agile report that:

1.

shows you a list of the incomplete issues in the sprint

2.

allows you to quickly view that list in the Issue Navigator

Which report meets this need?

- C. Cumulative Flow Diagram
- D. Sprint Report
- E. Velocity Chart

Correct Answer: D



A Sprint Report is also the best report to meet this need. As explained above, a Sprint Report shows a list of the incomplete issues in the sprint and allows you to quickly view that list in the Issue Navigator. A Sprint Report can help you investigate why your team failed to meet their last sprint commitment by showing you how many issues were added or removed during the sprint, how many issues were completed or not completed, and how much work was carried over to the next sprint. QUESTION 5

Correct Answer: CE

When a project is created with a shared configuration, it inherits the configurations of an existing project. This includes the workflow, issue types, screens, fields, permissions, notifications, and schemes associated with them.
